COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Dangerous Weapons-Drive by Shooting toward person, occupied motor vehicle or occupied building

Minnesota Statute: 609.66.1e(b), with reference to: 609.11.5

Maximum Sentence: 10 years or \$20,000 or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/03/2021

Control #(ICR#): 21159539

Charge Description: On or about August 3, 2021, in the County of Ramsey, Minnesota, Jacob Savon Gunn did while in or having just exited from a motor vehicle, recklessly discharge a firearm at or toward another occupied motor vehicle.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On August 3, 2021, at 1538 hours, St. Paul squads responded to Payne and Minnehaha on a shots fired call. The caller reported that she was in a red GMC Denali and that a person in a tan Chevrolet was shooting at her vehicle.

Police located the tan Chevrolet at Payne and Minnehaha. The vehicle was a Chevrolet Cobalt with Minnesota License GMK693. The driver and sole occupant of the vehicle was **Jacob Savon Gunn, DOB 05/06/2002**. In plain view, police saw a gun magazine in the pocket of the driver-side front door.

A female, SB, drove up to the scene in a red Denali and identified GMK693 as the vehicle from which the shots were fired at her vehicle. The Denali had three additional occupants, TM, a 4-year-old female, and a 1-year-old male.

SB said that they were driving to a house on York approaching Earl of Frank when she saw the tan Chevrolet speeding up behind her. She heard gunshots from the Chevrolet and began to flee the area. She drove toward the East Team police station. She eventually lost the Chevrolet in traffic.

Officers observed two bullet holes in the Denali, one in the driver's door and the other in the rear passenger door on the driver's side. There was another hole in the rear of the Denali.

Officers searched the Chevrolet Cobalt and recovered a Glock 27 .40 caliber handgun under the driver's seat. There was a live round in the chamber. Police also recovered a live round from the center console of the vehicle. There was a magazine in the gun in addition to the magazine located in the door compartment.

Officers went to York and Frank and located four .40 caliber casings at the intersection.

When officers first stopped Gunn he uttered, "don't let that vehicle leave, they just robbed me." He asserted that TM "pulled a gun" on him and stated the he "took the gun." He claimed he was meeting up with someone to "buy something." He said his phone had messages about the sale. Officers provided his phone, but Gunn was unable to locate the messages.

Gunn declined a formal custodial interview with an investigator.

NOTICE: Pursuant to Minnesota Statute 609.49, subd. 1 (a) A person charged with or convicted of a felony and released from custody, with or without bail or recognizance, who intentionally fails to appear when required after having been notified that a failure to appear for a court appearance is a criminal offense, or after having been released on an order or condition that the release personally appear when required with respect to the charge or conviction, is guilty of a crime for failure to appear and may be sentenced to not more than one-half of the maximum term of imprisonment or fine, or both, provided for the underlying crime for which the person failed to appear, but this maximum sentence shall, in no case, be less than a term of imprisonment of one year and one day or a fine of \$1,500, or both.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

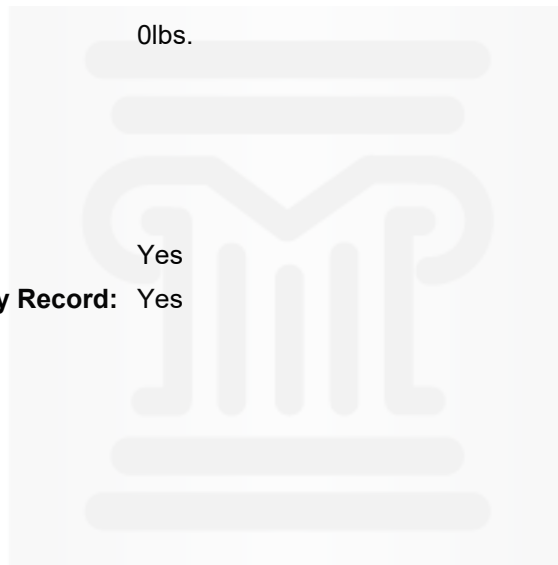
