COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Criminal Vehicular Operation - Great Bodily Harm - Driver Who Causes Collision Leaves Scene

Minnesota Statute: 609.2113.1(7), with reference to: 609.2113.1

Maximum Sentence: 5 YEARS AND/OR \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/01/2022

Control #(ICR#): 22002005

Charge Description: That on or about 6/1/2022, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, TAMMY RENAE OLSON did, by operating a motor vehicle, cause a collision that caused great bodily harm to Victim and TAMMY RENAE OLSON left the scene of that collision.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On June 1, 2022, at approximately 3:08 p.m., multiple people saw a black Audi sedan strike a pedestrian walking across Xerxes Avenue near Bass Lake Road in Brooklyn Center, Hennepin County, Minnesota. One of those people, Witness 1, called 911. Police responded and found a woman, Victim, unconscious and injured. She was transported to a hospital for emergency treatment. Hospital records indicate that Victim suffered extensive life-threatening injuries, including numerous broken bones from her legs to her neck, and serious internal bleeding. As of the filing of this complaint, Victim is unconscious, in critical condition, and not expected to survive her injuries.

Police spoke to Witness 1, who said that she watched as a black Audi struck Victim while she was walking across the street. She said the vehicle immediately drove away.

Police also spoke to Witness 2, who said that he was at a nearby Taco Bell drive-through prior to the accident. While at the drive-through, the woman driving the black Audi was behind him and yelling at him for not moving through the drive-through lane fast enough. Before the Audi drove away, Witness 2 took pictures of the car's Minnesota license plate DSU149 and of the driver: a woman, later identified as Defendant TAMMY RENAE OLSON. Witness 2 then watched as Defendant struck Victim with her Audi in the middle of Xerxes Avenue and immediately drove away.

Police learned that the DSU149 license plate was assigned to a black Audi and that Defendant was one of the registered owners of that car. At approximately 8:00 p.m. that evening, police arrested Defendant at her residence in Brooklyn Center. She was wearing the same clothing as she was in the pictures taken by Witness 2. Defendant also smelled like alcohol. In a post-Miranda statement Defendant said that she exited a restaurant parking lot and a woman ran out in front of her car. Defendant said she knew she had been involved in a crash, but she did not stop and drove straight to her house. Defendant admitted that she drank a few alcoholic beverages before she drove.

Police found Defendant's Audi in her garage. It had sustained front-end damage consistent with striking a pedestrian.

Police learned that Defendant's driver's license was cancelled as inimical to public safety. Defendant also has multiple convictions for driving while impaired, including a conviction for Driving While Impaired in the Second Degree in Hennepin County District Court file number 27-CR-17-27771 on or about November 28, 2017.

Defendant is currently in custody.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

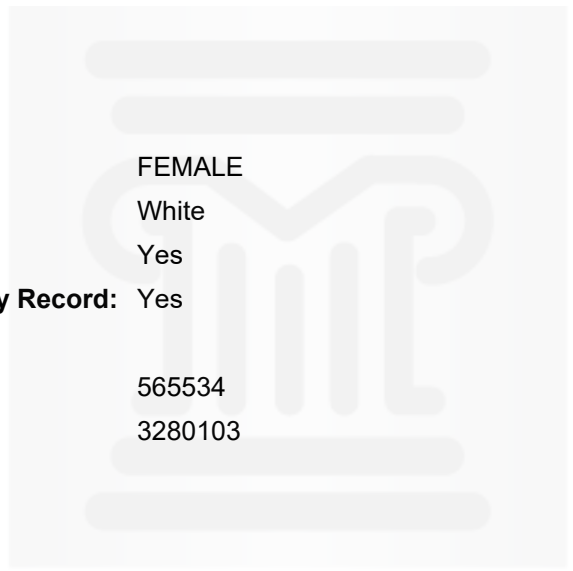
